DOMESTIC ABUSE CHARTER

- We understand domestic abuse to be the abuse of a person physically, sexually, psychologically, spiritually, emotionally, socially or financially within an intimate or family-type relationship that forms a pattern of coercive and controlling behaviour.
- 2. We believe in a God of love, justice, mercy and forgiveness and will teach that male and female were created equally in God's image.
- 3. We hold that domestic abuse in all its forms is unacceptable and irreconcilable with the Christian faith and Christian way of living.
- 4. We recognise that domestic abuse is a serious problem which can occur in church families as well as in wider society.
- 5. We undertake to listen, support and care for those affected by domestic abuse.
- 6. In accordance with our Safeguarding Policy we will always give the highest priority to the safety of children and vulnerable adults.
- 7. We will display information about domestic abuse support agencies.
- 8. The Parish Safeguarding Representatives will be guided by the Diocesan Safeguarding Adviser in following good practice and learning from statutory and voluntary support services.
